




PREP Data


- ▶ 996 children entered foster care
- ▶ 246 infants age 0-1
- ► 222 children age 2-5
- ▶ 285 children age 6-11
- ▶ 243 teens age 12-17






PREP Data Adverse Childhood Events

- ▶ 882 (89%) neglect
- ► 635 (64%) exposed to domestic violence
- ▶ 445 (45%) physical abuse
- Girls (32%) sexual abuse (Teens)
- Boys(21%) sexual abuse (Teens)
 52 (5%) parent death (10% Teens)
- 35% had >/= 4 adverse childhood events



SSRI use was not associated with overweight, stimulant use was negatively associated with overweight
