## For All Patients

- ✓ Focused Injury History (click for checklist)
- ✓ Full skin, oral, external GU exam
- ✓ Safety assessment (SW)
- ✓ Photo documentation of injury \*\*\*
- ✓ Contact CPT
- ✓ Consider trauma consult

## Must Notify CPT

- Child < 6 months old
- Injury (head, bruise, burn, fracture) in any infant **not** able to pull to stand
- Help w/ DCF Emergency Response
- Any death in the ED

\*\*\* Camera is in the ED SW office in the Wonder Woman lunchbox

## 0-6 months

- Must notify CPT
- Skeletal survey
- Head CT or brain MRI
- Ophtho consult, if intracranial blood
- Lab Evaluation
  - ✓ Urine Toxicology
  - ✓ AST/ALT
  - ✓ Labs as indicated for bruising/bleeding or fractures

### Lab Evaluation

- **Urine toxicology & expanded urine toxicology screen:** opiates, opioids (buprenorphine, methadone, oxycodone), barbiturates, benzodiazepines, cocaine, methamphetamines
- **Consider blood EtOH**
- **Bruising/bleeding:** CBC, PT/PTT (consider vWf panel, Factors VIII & IX, and Heme consult)
- **Fractures:** Ca, Mg, Phos, Alk Phos, iPTH, Vit D 25-OH



## 6-24 months

- Consult CPT
- Skeletal survey
- Low threshold for Head CT or brain MRI
- Ophtho if intracranial blood
- Lab Evaluation
  - ✓ Urine Toxicology
  - ✓ AST/ALT
  - ✓ Labs as indicated for bruising/bleeding or fractures

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### Lab Evaluation

- **Urine toxicology & expanded urine toxicology screen:**  
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(buprenorphine, methadone, oxycodone), barbiturates, benzodiazepines, cocaine methamphetamines
- **Consider blood EtoH**
- **Bruising/bleeding:** CBC, PT/PTT (consider vWf panel, Factors VIII & IX, and Heme consult)
- **Fractures:** Ca, Mg, Phos, Alk Phos, iPTH, Vit D 25-OH



## > 24 months

- Consult CPT
- Lab Evaluation
  - ✓ Urine Toxicology
  - ✓ AST/ALT
  - ✓ Labs as indicated for bruising/bleeding or fractures
- Consult CPT for any questions re 51A

NOTE: > 5 years, consider history from child

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
