

We are researchers from the University of New England Maine Leadership Education in Neurodevelopmental Disabilities (LEND) program looking into using parent recorded videos to identify whether or not your baby is at high risk for problems with sitting, walking, or other early movements and milestones.

Parents of newborns may be able to participate in this study if their baby meets the following:

- Was born after 32 weeks of pregnancy
- Is younger than 16 weeks old
- NICU admission and stay of 2+ days
- 1-minute APGAR scores of 5 or less
- Sentinel events such as cord prolapse, uterine rupture, prolonged resuscitation
- Development of seizures or delivery complications which include or may have included anoxic events.

What will you have to do?

- Sign a consent form
- Record 2-3 short videos of your child on your smartphone and submit them to a secure research database
- Complete a short (5 minute) survey
