

TELEHEALTH RESOURCES

The goal of the “Supporting Providers and Families to Access Telehealth and Distant Care Services for Pediatric Care” project is to support telehealth access and infrastructure for the provision of comprehensive care to children and adolescents, including children and youth with special health care needs (CYSHCN) and other vulnerable pediatric populations, utilizing a medical home approach during and after the COVID-19 pandemic.
